Ramblings from the Deacon.....

A year or so ago I asked Karen if putting the bulletin together had changed her experience of the service. I asked because for me, practicing my readings either gives me a deeper feeling for what the passage is saying to me, or raises questions that I didn't know I had. She agreed that it did change something for her as well.

One of the things we do at the Mission Area meetings is to read and reflect on a bible passage twice. The first time is at the beginning of the meeting, the second after our break and from a different source. We share what has prompted a response from us. The last time we met in Grand Marais the reading was Matthew 14:22-33, where Peter walks on water. Obviously that wasn't the first time I had heard that passage. Maybe it was because I had just completed a long peaceful drive through beautiful countryside, or maybe it was the way the speaker read the lines, but a totally unexpected thought came to me. What about the others? Peter wasn't the only one who was afraid. I don't think that he could have been the only one who had doubts. Assuming that to one degree or another, they all felt the same, I wondered if they were having an 'I could have had a V8' moment. "I could have walked on water." What an experience to miss. Being the kind of person I am, I was reluctant to speak up in the first round of sharing. And, I realized that had I been in the boat, I would have missed the chance to walk on water. I shared my thoughts with the second reading. 'Are you ready to get out of the boat?' is an important part of my life now.

When I practice my readings sometimes I gain understanding, sometimes I have questions, and sometimes I'm left wondering what will Lynn or Sam do with this? Below is the link to the 2016 lectionary. It's also in the prayer book, but I can never remember what year we're in. If it fits, try reading the gospel a couple of times a week, maybe pausing in different places or seeing how a different emphasis creates a new understanding. Emphasis works particularly well for me with the Lord's Prayer. "*Thy* will" – not mine. Rats. "As we forgive" lifts resentment I may not have realized I was carrying.
