Holy Trinity Episcopal Church 2017 Vestry Report

Lot 6, Plat of Dawn View, Koochiching County, a generous gift from Clyde Franklin, sold for \$60,500 following rejection of several very low offers. Total amount to HTEC after expenses \$55,927.01. This undeveloped lake lot is 100' by 1000' with real estate taxes of \$1,000 per year which have been paid by the church for three years. A request for non-profit status was denied by the county. The sale and deed needed language provided by the Standing Committee of the Episcopal Church in Minnesota and approval by the Bishop. It also included indicating that Holy Trinity is in International Falls as there are several Holy Trinity Episcopal churches in Minnesota. The funds from this sale were deposited in the Pooled Income Fund.

HTEC has a contract with Citizens for Backus/AB for plowing the parking lot across from the church. The work is done by Steve Boyum at a rate of \$65/ hour for pickup/plow and \$90/hour for big loader. Our church pays one-third of the cost for plowing on a monthly basis. Because we are the only church paying toward plowing, the vestry used Outreach Funds for the first monthly payment this fall.

\$500 was transferred to the Discretionary Fund.

Annual dues paid to the Northeast Mission Area of the Episcopal Church of Minnesota in the amount of \$50.

Church Secretary, Karen Walls took on additional duties: Parochial Report, lay responsibilities schedule, bills, (prep & mail), deposits, record pledges and do pledge statements, and the 1099's for taxes.

Sidewalk shoveling and lawn care are under contract with Huffaker Lawn and Snow Service.

Church cleaning is done by Maureen Jackson once a week.

Front entry doors were painted (#413 – Pratt and Lambert Our Classic Red from Falls Lumber) by a couple whose marriage ceremony was provided by Deacon Lee Grim in exchange for the work.

Fire Extinguishers were updated and replaced by Glen Anderson, technician. A contract for this yearly service was signed. Wilbur Tveit installed the new extinguisher in the church kitchen.

Corrin's plumbing did some repairs on the water heater. It was switching off when there was high demand. The repair was completed for \$270.05. They also repaired the toilet in the women's downstairs bathroom.

Duties of the church treasurer were compiled with help from Gary Davison and Andy Wright took on those duties. Thank you to both of you. Following the treasurer change, account signatures were updated.

One Saturday morning of serious kitchen cleaning was held with four members of the congregation pitching-in.

Robin and Becky Monahan presented information on "Move to Amend" and asked our church congregation to sign a petition in support of amending the US Constitution so that corporations are not considered persons.

A joint Team and Vestry meeting was held in October with The Reverend Andy Berry of Littlefork Lutheran Church providing leadership for the discussions on physical accessibility, serving Eucharist at Falls Good Samaritan Center, Backus Community Café volunteer dates, summer services at the lake, Ruby's Pantry, describing the duties of and finding a parish administrator, contacting current lay readers about future needs for their services, building community with children – foster care children especially and those aging out of the system, "Move to Amend," church web page, Sunday school needs, expanding the team, getting additional vestry members, and faith formation.

An Automatic Electronic Defibrillator (AED) was installed in the church and training sessions are being scheduled.

Accessibility is being addressed on a temporary basis with the installation of a lift for the steps from the inside vestibule to the floor level of the sanctuary. Plans and bids are in the works. This plan also includes a ramp to circumvent the two steps outside.

Continuing discussions and challenges: physical accessibility, use of building by outside groups, keys and the need for Safe Church Training. an energy audit, "Move to Amend." Submitted by,


