Knowing Our Connectedness

In the 15th chapter of John, Jesus teaches his disciples; "I am the vine, you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing." (John 15:5) Often, it's a passage that is thought about as teaching about Christian living with the fruit we bear being Christian actions like giving of ourselves to make sure the hungry are fed and the naked clothed. This is a good and proper way of understanding Jesus' teaching about the vine and the branches but there is another deeper and even more important lesson for everyone in this passage.

Jesus is informing everyone, Jews, Gentiles, Christians and non-believers, that God alone is the source of all life. Far too often, we think of ourselves and our own hard-work as the source of who we are and what we have; yet, we deceive ourselves. Jesus reveals a foundational truth in this teaching that our life, our abilities to think, the relationships we have and our abilities to work and play are all gifts given exclusively through our connection with God. We are as dependent on God for everything, as a branch is on its vine for life and if we are cut off for any reason we will wither and die.

It might sound like a cliché but realizing that all we have and all that we are is because of our connection to God transforms the way we see and think about everything. We are not owners or consumers but caretakers of the gifts that are the lives, abilities, time and resources God has entrusted to our keeping. Knowing this truth is the foundation of thankfulness and deep trust in God.
