Ramblings from the Liturgist.....

I don't know how many of you use "Forward Day by Day" as part of your daily devotions, but just let me say, it is a very good and often thought provoking way to start your day. Over the years I have kept the small books, marking certain pages that contain thoughts or sayings that spoke to me. So this month I am going to share some of them with you.

From Tuesday, June 3rd, 2014. Bible reading is Ephesians 3: 20. "to him who by the power at work within us is able to accomplish abundantly far more than all we can ask or imagine----- From the writer for that month-------When I pray, I spend a lot of energy on getting the words right. Whether I'm praying out loud or in my heart, somehow I need to say exactly the right thing. Often I get so tangled up in saying it right, I don't say anything at all! (How true is this!). God knows what we need. God knows what the people we pray for need. "I have come to give you life abundant". Says Jesus.

From Monday June 30th, 2014. Bible reading is 2nd Timothy 4:3. "For the time is coming when people will not put up with sound doctrine. But having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own desires. "----- From the writer of the month ----- God's preference is for more people to be included, for more people to be loved. So whenever the circle is shrinking, where people are being excluded or disliked, God is not served.

From Sunday, August 17th, 2014. Bible reading is Matthew 15:26-27. "Jesus said" it is not fair to take the children's food and throw it to the dogs". And she replied, "Yes, Lord, yet even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from the masters table". From the writer-----why I like this story so much is that the woman did not take no for an answer. Jesus called her a dog and she took him on what matters to Jesus is people engaging with him, not agreeing with him. Engaging is the core of a relationship. And relationship is the very essence of faith.

From Tuesday, September 9th, 2014. Bible reading is from Job 29:1-4. "Oh that I were as in the months of old, as in the days when God watched over me; ------ From the writer of the month-----each day is its' own gift, and today is precious. Rejoice in the golden light of these waning days of summer. Enjoy evenings on porches and patios and catching up with neighbors and friends. God loves us yesterday, today, and tomorrow, but today is the day to appreciate and celebrate.

From Friday, November 12th, 2010. Bible reading is from James 1:16-27."Every generous act of giving, with every perfect gift, is from above, coming down from the Father of lights." ------ From the writer for the month------ The meaning of this verse is obscure in some ways, but one thing is clear enough: temptation cannot come from God: everything that comes from God is good. If we find this a pious platitude, perhaps we haven't examined it carefully.

And these are just a few of the words and thoughts that claimed my attention. This little book is a positive way to start your day! I'll close with this poem.
