I feel very blessed to have been able to see our bishop "in action", so to speak. And our deacon as well. The people of Warroad were as pleased to see him as much as the bishop! We were warmly welcomed, treated very well, and left with an invitation to return any time. We as Episcopalians are very fortunate to have a bishop who listens to us, has our spiritual welfare as a top priority, and best of all, is available to us. Bishop Loya is indeed a blessing to our congregation and we should be grateful for his leadership.


